IN LOVING MEMORY OF BOB LUPONE (1946 - 2022)

MCC Theater's founding Co-Artistic Director Bob LuPone passed away Saturday, August 27, 2022 after a three year battle with pancreatic cancer. He is survived by his wife Virginia, his son Orlando, sister Patti, and brother William. He is also survived by the profound impact he had on us.

When Bernie Telsey and Bob LuPone met in the early 1980's they struck a creative spark called Manhattan Class Company, and, joined by Will Cantler not long after, formed a unique artistic leadership trio that has burned ever since. While the company was ostensibly formed to create new work for the American stage, it was always Bob's fierce need for engagement with the art, the artists, and the audience that influenced and inspired us.

Whenever we considered a play, Bob always made us ask ourselves if it had a "third act"? Would we walk out of the theater anxious to go to the bar or restaurant and spend the rest of the night hashing over what we had seen? That perspective has animated every decision we've ever made.



Some of our fondest memories are of the MCC Marathon Weekend retreats we did in the early days, where Bob would lead a group of actors, directors, and playwrights to a ramshackle retreat house on Long Island to read first drafts of new plays, eat, drink, and talk all weekend, as his mother Pat made food for us. For many of us, Bob created a sense of community that we had not yet found in New York, and which we have treasured ever since.

Bob was fiercely opinionated about plays, and just as fiercely unedited in his note sessions. If Bernie and Will sometimes paused about how or when to give a note, Bob always trusted that charging straight in with passion and candor would win the day, and we came to learn just how often he was right. Although we fought often, the unruly passion of those days ripened into a trust of talking and listening that we hope permeates the whole culture of MCC today.

After more than two decades of dreaming we opened the Robert W. Wilson MCC Theater Space in January of 2019 with a balloon drop from the Newman Mills Stage. Bob's joy at finally having a home for MCC lifted us all right up to the grid where those balloons came from.

Bob was a force, an advocate, complex in the richest ways, overflowing with a youthful enthusiasm, and deeply wise as he looked in to our souls. He was our best friend. It is hard to believe that we will never sit down with him again and say "Let's talk."

EDUCATION PROGRAMS

Since 1999, MCC THEATER has used the power of theater to excite minds, foster a collaborative and creative community for New York City high school students across all five boroughs, investing in the next generation of theatermakers. Every year, more than 1200 New York City students' lives are transformed through our programs, cultivating in them a deep appreciation for the arts and its power to engage and affect change.

Driven by our mission to provoke conversations, we are committed to using the power of theater to ask some of the essential questions of our times. Our **EDUCATION** programs break down barriers to embolden students and young audiences to deepen their CURIOSITY and find confidence in THEIR VOICES. Those voices are uplifted as their words are woven together to form the fabric of our UNCENSORED, BKYC UNCENSORED and FRESHPLAY performances.





After making a seamless transition to remote learning in March of 2020, MCC continues to adapt and innovate to meet the changing needs of our students and community; offering LIVE online performances of all our culminating productions and implementing hybrid after-school and in-school programs.

This year we were thrilled to host our first in-person performances of UNCENSORED and BKYC UNCENSORED in two years. Last July, our staged reading festival for FRESHPLAY returned home to the MCC Theater stage.

We continue the long and valued relationships with our four partner schools: Manhattan International High School, Baruch College Campus High School, The High School for Law and Public Service on the George Washington High School Campus in Manhattan, and The High School for Public Service in Brooklyn. We are committed to providing quality arts-based education because youth voices matter and creating an inclusive space where everyone's stories are heard can inspire change in ourselves and in society.

Throughout the pandemic MCC's Education Department virtually served from MAR 2020-JUN 2021:

- **103 STUDENTS** in our after school Youth Company programs
- **925 STUDENTS** across our in-school partnerships within four high schools in NYC
- **199 STUDENTS** were served through our Virtual Student Matinee program

THE ROBERT W. WILSON MCC THEATER SPACE

Inaugurated on JAN 9, 2019, MCC's new Hell's Kitchen home, **THE ROBERT W. WILSON MCC THEATER SPACE**, is a state-of-the-art complex designed for us to do what we do best: shake things up. The space houses two theaters, two rehearsal studios, extensive backstage facilities, administrative offices, and ample audience amenities.

THE NEWMAN MILLS THEATER is named for Ruth & Harold[†] Newman and Marianne & Steve Mills. As dedicated co-chairs of The Campaign for MCC THEATER, they led a successful fundraising effort in support of MCC's education and artistic programs.

THE SUSAN & RONALD FRANKEL THEATER is named for Susan & Ronald Frankel. They have been active with the company since 2015. Susan Frankel is also an MCC THEATER Board member.

ROBERT W. WILSON was a well-known and successful investor from the mid-1960's to the mid-1980's. After retirement, he devoted his life to philanthropy. He was a transformative philanthropist, primarily funding worldwide organizations in the preservation and conservation areas. An avid New Yorker, he was also involved with a number of New York's cultural institutions. He was a major supporter of, and held leadership roles with, the Brooklyn Botanic Garden, Environmental Defense Fund, The Metropolitan Opera, the Whitney Museum, and the World Monuments Fund. In addition, he and the Trust continue to support the above institutions and The Nature Conservancy, The New York Public Library, Central Park Conservancy, BAM, and the Wildlife Conservation Society.

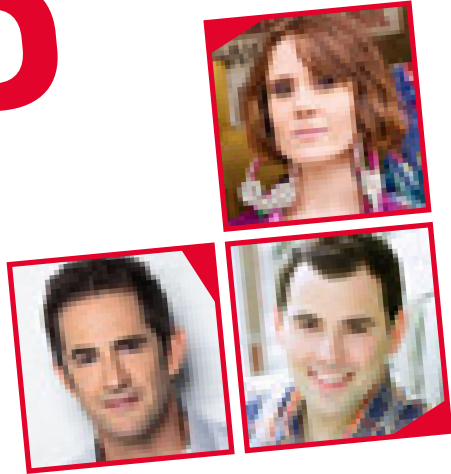

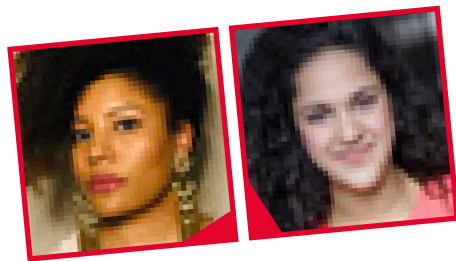

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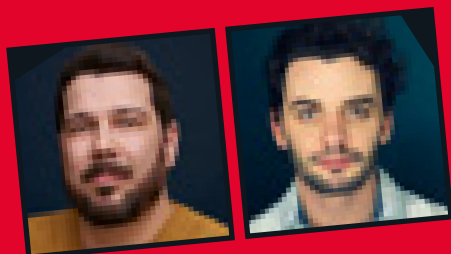
